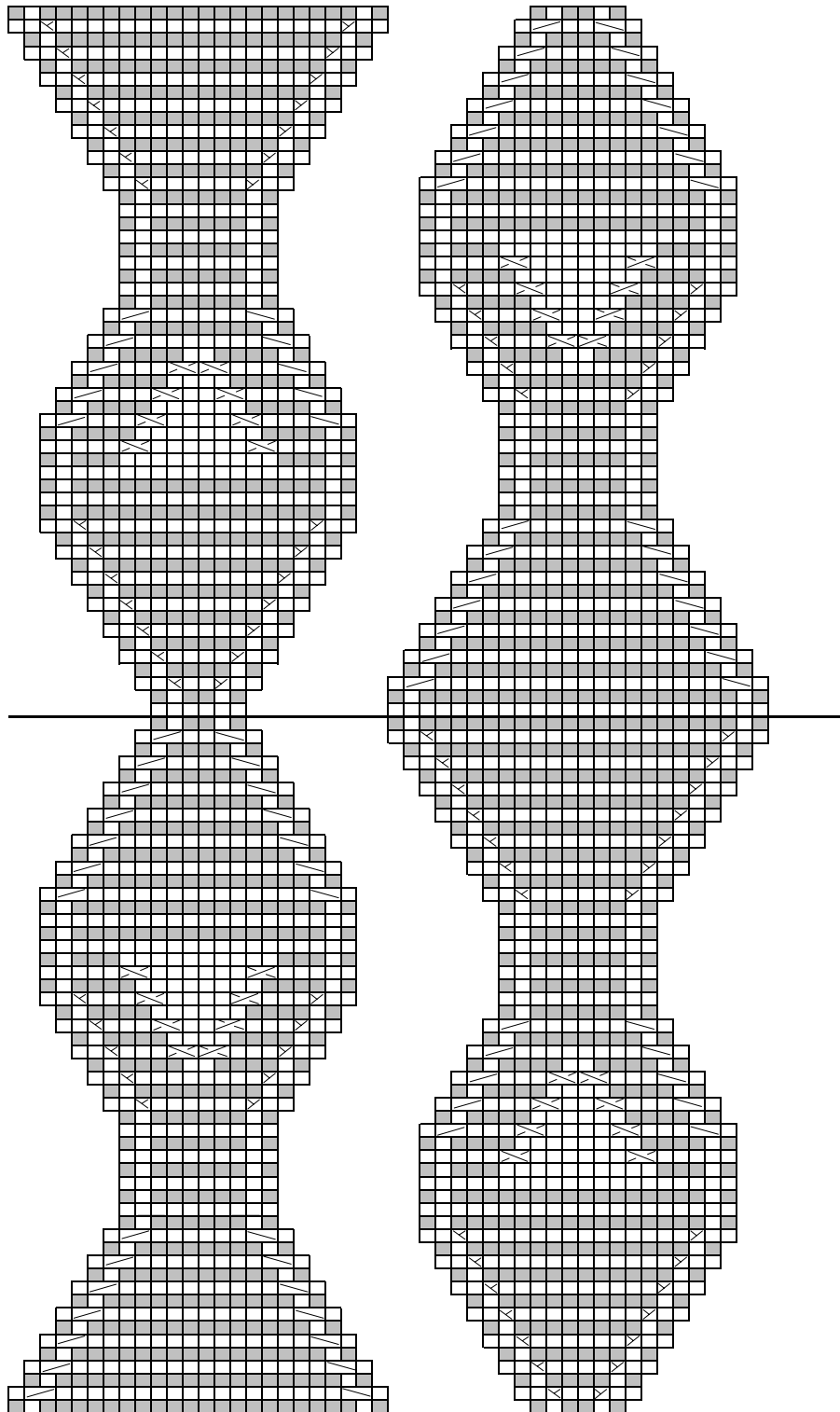










# mille's fish!

# mille's fish!

this is my version of the popular patterns for fish blankets, i do not take credit for the original idea, only my revision of it.  
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-  knit on right side, purl on wrong side
-  knit on wrong side
-  knit 2 together
-  slip one, knit next, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch
-  pick up yarn between stitches on last row knitwise, knit through back loop (M1L)
-  pick up yarn between stitches on last row purlwise, knit stitch through front loop (M1R)
-  knit 2nd stitch on left needle in front of work (without slipping it off the left needle) knit 1st stitch on left needle, slip both knitted stitches off left needle
-  knit 2nd stitch on left needle in back of work (without slipping it off the left needle) knit 1st stitch on left needle, slip both knitted stitches off left needle

i knit the fish together as i go along, which means that some is knit from the tail up and some from the nose up.

this chart shows both versions as they are knit in a slightly different manner. change colour by the thick black line.

i crochet the fish together with chain stitches in a contrasting colour.
